What is the Lake St. Louis Anglers Club?

As early as 1971 there was a small group of residents that started a fishing club. They had a few tournaments and with the CA they made sure that fish were stocked in the lakes from time to time. In 1981, residents that wanted to continue what the earlier group started formed the Lake St. Louis Anglers Club. For a \$20 annual membership fee, the whole family could participate in all of the activities the Anglers sponsored. Today, our membership has grown to include about 80 families. Our calendar has grown to the point where we sponsor or participate in over 20 events including: Weekly Bass Tournaments, Kid's Fishing Derby, Habitat Workday, Lake Clean-Up Day, Crappie and Catfish Tournaments as well as various social events. We also sponsor a monthly fish contest and award prizes for the biggest catch of the year for each species of fish.

Conservation/Education

The Lake St. Louis Anglers Club consults with the Missouri Department of Conservation whenever conservation concerns or issues arise. The MDC has assisted us in creating a plan that allows us to improve water quality and fish populations in our lakes. The Missouri Department of Conservation has also helped us to initiate a vegetation/habitat program that is aimed at helping to reduce siltation and bank erosion as well as creating habitat for fish.

The Anglers occasionally have special guests at our meeting to speak on various topics such as, boating safety, boat maintenance and winterizing, fishing techniques, sonar and electronic graphing, community updates, etc.

Membership Benefits

As a member of the Lake St. Louis Anglers Club, you will receive our monthly newsletter packed with valuable information on conservation issues and our event schedule.

Please follow all catch and release guidelines that are posted on signs around the lakes.
